The collection - which launched at Decorex in September as part of Alternative Flooring's Quirky B series - includes four designs from the Liberty archive, upscaled and recoloured. The boldly coloured 'Flowers of Thorpe' pattern, shown here outside a house in Somerset, is based on a 1968 design. ## LANDMARK MOMENT

In a bid to appeal to a younger generation, The Landmark Trust - the brilliant charity responsible for rescuing important historic buildings and making them available for holiday lets - has launched the Young Landmarkers for under thirties. It is hoped the scheme will lure a new audience more familiar with trawling Airbnb for holiday rentals. It costs £25 a year, and members will benefit from 20 per cent discounts at selected properties, priority booking for newly restored buildings, invitations to social events throughout the year and a free copy of *The Landmark Trust Handbook*. There are 198 properties to pick from, with highlights ranging from the cosy - such as 13 Princelet Street, an eighteenth-century house in the heart of trendy Spitalfields - to the astonishing - a lighthouse on Lundy and an old water tower in Norfolk. A handful of properties are also large enough to accommodate big gatherings, such as Wortham Manor, a Tudor house in Devon that sleeps 15, and Saddell House in Argyll and Bute, which sleeps 13. *Until January 2*

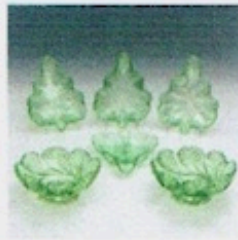
